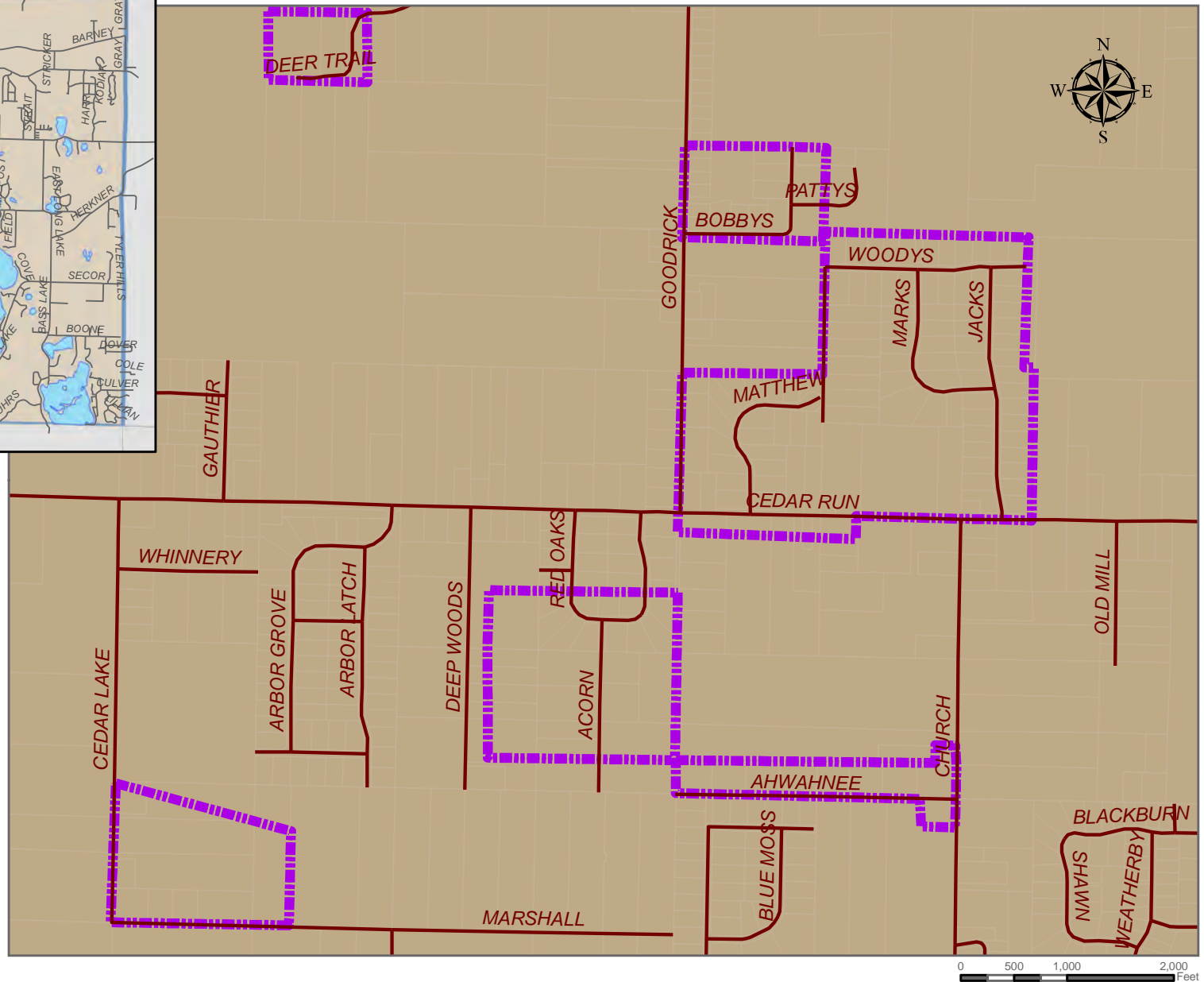


This map indicates areas in the Township where gypsy moths may be present. This is according to an egg mass survey completed by the Grand Traverse Conservation District. The counts are fairly low, therefore, no aerial spray will be conducted. There are a number of actions landowners can take on their own to reduce the nuisance level of an infestation on their land. Also, if we have a wet/cold spring this could make a big difference in the infestation.
